WEATHER OUTLOOK ISSUED ON 24.01.2025 AND

VALID 00:00 25.01.2025 TO 23:59 27.01.2025

FORECAST OUTLOOK:

Saturday 25th: Moderate dust haze with horizontal visibility range of 2 – 5km is anticipated over the Northern cities throughout the forecast period. Moderate dust haze with horizontal visibility range of 2 – 5km is expected over the North Central region during the forecast period. Moderate dust haze with horizontal visibility range of 2 – 5km is expected over parts of Oyo, Ekiti and Ondo while the remaining parts of the inland states of the South are expected be hazy with patches of clouds throughout the forecast period. In the coastal region, cloudy skies with spells of sunshine are anticipated during the morning period. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are expected over parts of Lagos, Bayelsa, Ogun, Ondo Delta, Rivers, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states.

Sunday 26th: Slight dust haze is anticipated over the Northern region of the country throughout the forecast period. Moderate dust haze with horizontal visibility range of 2 – 5km is expected over the North Central region throughout the forecast period. Patches of clouds in hazy atmosphere is expected over the inland and coastal cities of the South with chances of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Cross River, Rivers, Akwa Ibom, Bayelsa, Ondo and Edo states in the afternoon/evening periods.

Monday 27th: Slight dust haze is anticipated over the Northern region of the country throughout the forecast period. Slight dust haze is anticipated over the North central region of the country throughout the forecast period. Hazy atmosphere with patches of clouds are expected over inland and coastal cities of the south during the morning hours. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are expected over parts of Ondo, Delta, Rivers, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states in the afternoon/evening periods.

Advisory:

- i. Dust particles are in suspension, public should take necessary precaution.
- ii. People with Asthmatic health condition and other respiratory issues should be cautious of the present weather condition.
- iii. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- iv. Adhere to safety advisories issued by relevant authorities.
- v. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
