WEATHER OUTLOOK ISSUED ON 21.02.2025 AND

VALID 00:00 22.02.2025 TO 23:59 24.02.2025

FORECAST OUTLOOK:

Saturday 22ND: Sunny and hazy skies are expected over the Northern region throughout the forecast period. Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the North Central region with prospects of localized thunderstorms over parts of Kwara and Kogi states during the afternoon/evening hours. In the Southern parts of the country, cloudy skies with spells of sunshine are expected over the Inland states and Coastal region with prospect of morning thunderstorms over parts of Lagos, Edo and Delta states. In the afternoon/evening hours, localized thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Ondo, Ogun, Edo, Ebonyi, Ekiti, Abia, Anambra, Osun, Oyo, Imo, Enugu, Lagos, Cross River, Rivers, Akwa Ibom, Bayelsa and Delta states.

Sunday 23RD: Sunny and hazy skies are expected over the Northern region throughout the forecast period. Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the North Central region with prospects of localized thunderstorm over parts of Nasarawa, Plateau, Kogi, Benue and the Federal Capital Territory during the afternoon/evening hours. In the Southern parts of the country, cloudy skies with spells of sunshine are expected over the Inland states and Coastal region during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, localized thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Ondo, Osun, Ogun, Oyo, Ekiti, Abia, Anambra, Imo, Ebonyi, Enugu, Edo, Lagos, Cross River, Rivers, Akwa Ibom, Bayelsa and Delta states.

Monday 24TH: Sunny skies are expected over the Northern region throughout the forecast period. Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the North Central region with prospects of localized thunderstorm over parts of Kogi and Benue in the afternoon/evening hours. In the Southern parts of the country, cloudy skies with spells of sunshine are expected over the Inland and the Coastal regions of the country in the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, localized thunderstorms are anticipated over

Enugu, Imo, Abia, Ebonyi, Oyo, Ondo, Ogun, Ekiti, Osun, Edo, Lagos, Delta, Cross River, Rivers, Akwa Ibom and Bayelsa states.

Advisory:

- i. Dust particles are in suspension, public should take necessary precaution.
- ii. People with Asthmatic health condition and other respiratory issues should be cautious of the present weather condition.
- iii. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- iv. Adhere to safety advisories issued by relevant authorities.
- v. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
