WEATHER OUTLOOK ISSUED ON 30.04.2025 AND

VALID 00:00 1.05.2025 TO 23:59 3.05.2025

FORECAST OUTLOOK:

Thursday 1st: Light to moderate dust haze are expected within the forecast period over parts of northern Borno, Yobe, Jigawa and Katsina states while thunderstorms are expected over parts of Taraba state during the morning hours. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Adamawa, Kaduna, Gombe, Zamfara, Bauchi, Kebbi and Taraba states. Sunny skies with patches of cloud are anticipated over the North Central region with prospects of morning thunderstorms over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Niger and Kwara states. Later in the day, thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Benue, Plateau, Niger, Nasarawa and Kogi states during the afternoon/evening periods. Over the Southern region, cloudy skies with spells of sunshine are expected with chances of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Delta, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Rivers and Bayelsa states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening periods, thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Ogun, Ekiti, Ondo, Oyo, Edo, Abia, Imo, Enugu, Ebonyi, Anambra, Bayelsa, Lagos, Delta, Rivers, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states

Friday 2nd: Light to moderate dust haze are anticipated over parts of Borno, Yobe, Jigawa and Katsina states throughout the forecast period with prospects of thunderstorms over parts of Taraba state during the morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms are expected over parts of Taraba state. Sunny skies with patches of cloud are expected over the North Central region with chances of morning thunderstorms over parts of Niger and Kwara states within the morning periods. Later in the day, thunderstorms are anticipated over most parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Plateau, Benue and Kogi states. In the Southern region, thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Ogun, Edo, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Rivers and Lagos states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening periods thunderstorms are envisaged over parts of Imo, Enugu, Ebonyi, Anambra, Abia, Ondo, Ogun, Osun, Ekiti and Lagos states.

Saturday 3rd: Light to moderate dust haze is expected to persist over parts of Borno, Yobe, Jigawa and Katsina states during the forecast period while morning thunderstorms are expected over parts of Taraba state. Sunny skies with patches of cloud are expected over the North Central region within the forecast period. In the Southern region, cloudy skies are anticipated with prospects of afternoon/evening thunderstorms over parts of Enugu, Imo, Anambra, Abia, Ebonyi, Ogun, Osun, Oyo, Ekiti, Ondo, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Rivers Edo, Delta, Lagos and Bayelsa states.

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- ii. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
