WEATHER OUTLOOK ISSUED ON 03.05.2025 AND

VALID 00:00 04.05.2025 TO 23:59 06.05.2025

FORECAST OUTLOOK:

Sunday 4th: Moderate dust haze with horizontal visibility of 2-5km is expected over the Northern region with prospect of localized visibility of less than 1000m anticipated over parts of Sokoto, Kano, Yobe, Jigawa, Zamfara, Borno, Bauchi, Gombe and Katsina states throughout the forecast period with chances of localized thunderstorms over parts of southern Adamawa and Taraba states in the afternoon/evening hours. In the North-central region, sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated with prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Kogi, Kwara and Benue states during the afternoon/evening hours. In the Southern region, isolated morning thunderstorms are expected over parts of Cross River, Bayelsa, Delta, Akwa Ibom and Rivers states. Later in the day, thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Osun, Ogun, Ondo, Oyo, Ekiti, Edo, Imo, Abia, Anambra, Enugu, Ebonyi, Rivers, Cross River, Bayelsa, Akwa Ibom, Delta and Lagos states.

Monday 5th: Moderate dust haze is expected over the Northern region throughout the forecast period with prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Taraba and Adamawa states during the afternoon/evening hours. Partly cloudy skies are anticipated over the North Central region in the morning hours. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Benue, Kwara, and Kogi states. In the Southern region, morning thunderstorms are expected over Bayelsa, Cross River, Akwa Ibom and Rivers states. Later in the day, thunderstorms are expected over most parts of the region.

Tuesday 6th: Slight dust haze is expected over the Northern region throughout the forecast period with prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Taraba and Adamawa states during the afternoon/evening hours. Cloudy skies with sunshine intervals are anticipated over the North Central region in the morning hours. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory,

Nasarawa, and Niger states. In the South, morning thunderstorms are expected over Cross River and Akwa Ibom states. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are expected over most parts of the region.

Advisory:

- i. Dust particles are in suspension, public should take necessary precaution.
- ii. People with respiratory issues should be cautious of the present weather condition.
- iii. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- iv. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- v. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- vi. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- vii. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- viii. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
