FORECAST OUTLOOK:

Wednesday 7th: Sunny skies are expected over the Northern region with chances of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Adamawa, and Taraba state during the afternoon/evening hours. In the North-central region, isolated thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Plateau, Kogi and Nasarawa states during the afternoon/evening period. In the South, there are chances of morning thunderstorms over parts of Cross River, Rivers, Bayelsa and Akwa Ibom states. Later in the day, thunderstorms are expected over parts of Ebonyi, Ogun, Osun, Imo, Anambra, Enugu, Edo, Oyo, Ondo, Ekiti, Lagos, Abia, Rivers, Cross River, Bayelsa, Akwa Ibom and Delta states.

Thursday 8th: In the Northern region, Sunny skies are expected over the region with chances of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Adamawa and Taraba states during the afternoon/evening hours. In the North Central region, isolated thunderstorms are expected over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Benue, Nasarawa, Plateau, Kwara, Niger, and Kogi states during the afternoon/evening period. In the Southern region, morning thunderstorms are expected over parts of Cross River and Akwa Ibom states. Thunderstorms are expected over parts of Abia, Imo, Ebonyi, Enugu, Anambra, Edo, Rivers, Cross River, Bayelsa, Akwa Ibom, Ogun, Osun, Oyo, Ondo, Ekiti, Lagos, and Delta states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Friday 9th: Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected across the Northern region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Adamawa and Taraba state in the afternoon/evening hours. In the North Central region, isolated thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Niger, the Federal Capital Territory, Plateau, Kogi, Nasarawa, Kwara and Benue states during the afternoon/evening hours. In the Southern region, morning thunderstorms are expected over parts of Bayelsa and Delta states. Later in the

day, thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Ekiti, Lagos, Oyo, Osun, Ondo, Ogun, Abia, Imo, Anambra, Ebonyi, Enugu, Delta, Edo, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states.

Advisory:

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- ii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision
- iii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
