



WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST BULLETIN NO: 202505005 ISSUED ON: 6th MAY, 2025. VALID: FROM 7th MAY, 2025 TO 13th MAY, 2025.

REMARKS

During the week, the Madden-Julian Oscillation (MJO) is expected to be weak over the West African region. Good moisture influx and velocity potential are expected to enhance the prospects of Moderate rainfall over parts of Taraba state. Low to Moderate rainfall is expected over parts of Kaduna, Nasarawa, Benue, the Federal Capital Territory, Kogi, Ogun, Lagos, Osun, Ondo, Anambra, Imo, Abia, Enugu, Ebonyi, Edo, Delta, Bayelsa, Rivers, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states, while low rainfall is expected in the remaining parts of the country.

<u>Advisory</u>: There are prospects of flash floods on roads, bridges & low-lying areas which can disrupt vehicular traffic. The public is advised to take necessary safety precautions; do not walk through fast-flowing runoff waters.





FIGURE 1: SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF ANTICIPATED RAINFALL.

2.1 Maximum Temperature

Maximum Temperature range of 39°C and above is anticipated over Borno, Yobe, Gombe, Jigawa, Katsina, Zamfara, Sokoto, Kebbi, parts of Adamawa, Taraba, Plateau, Bauchi, Kaduna, Kano, Kwara and Niger states. Temperature range of 34 – 38°C is expected over the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, parts of Benue, Kogi, Plateau, Adamawa, Taraba, Kaduna, Kogi, Benue Kano, Kaduna, Niger, Kwara, Oyo, Ekiti, Osun, Ogun, Enugu and Ebonyi states. Temperature range of 29 – 33°C is expected over the rest parts of the country. See Figure 2.

2.2 <u>Minimum Temperature</u>




FIGURE 3: SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF MINIMUM TEMPERATURE FORECAST.

Minimum temperature range of 26°C and above is expected over Sokoto, Kebbi, Borno, Yobe, Gombe, Parts of Kano, Katsina, Jigawa, Zamfara, Bauchi, Adamawa, Taraba, Plateau, Niger, Kaduna, Nasarawa, Kwara, Benue, Lagos, Ogun, Ondo, Delta, Bayelsa, Rivers, Akwa Ibom, Cross River and the Federal Capital Territory. Temperature range of 21 - 25°C is expected over most parts of the country except for southern Taraba where Temperature range of 16 - 20°C is expected. See Figure 3.
