WEATHER OUTLOOK ISSUED ON 12.05.2025 AND

FORECAST OUTLOOK:

Tuesday 13th: Sunny skies are expected over the Northern region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Taraba and Adamawa states during the afternoon/evening hours. In the North-central region, sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated in the morning. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are expected over parts of Plateau, the Federal Capital Territory, Kwara and Kogi states during the afternoon/evening period. In the South, there are chances of morning thunderstorms over parts of Cross River and Akwa Ibom states. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms are expected over parts of Ogun, Ondo, Osun, Oyo, Ekiti, Ebonyi, Imo, Anambra, Abia, Enugu, Edo, Lagos, Rivers, Cross River, Bayelsa, Akwa Ibom and Delta states.

Wednesday 14th: In the Northern region, sunny skies are expected during the morning hours. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms are envisaged over parts of Taraba, Adamawa, Bauchi, Gombe and Kaduna states. In the North-central region, sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated with prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Plateau, the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa and Kogi states during the afternoon/evening period. In the Southern region, morning thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Abia, Imo, Cross River, Bayelsa and Akwa Ibom states. Thunderstorms are expected over parts of Abia, Enugu, Anambra, Ondo, Ogun, Oyo, Osun, Cross River, Bayelsa, Akwa Ibom, Lagos and Delta states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Thursday 15th: Sunny skies with few clouds are expected over the Northern region with chances of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Kaduna, Adamawa, Taraba, Gombe, Kano and Jigawa states during the afternoon/evening period. In the North-central region, morning isolated thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa and Benue states. During the afternoon/evening

period, localized thunderstorms are envisaged over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Kogi, Plateau and Benue states. Over the Southern region, morning thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states. Later in the day, thunderstorms are envisaged over parts of Ebonyi, Imo, Abia, Anambra, Enugu, Osun, Ogun, Oyo, Ondo, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Rivers, Delta, Bayelsa and Lagos states.

Advisory:

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- ii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision
- iii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
