WEATHER OUTLOOK UPDATE ISSUED ON 13.05.2025 AND

VALID 00:00 14.05.2025 TO 23:59 16.05.2025

FORECAST OUTLOOK:

Wednesday 14th: Sunny skies are expected over the Northern region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Taraba, Yobe, Borno, Kaduna, Kebbi, Zamfara, Bauchi, Gombe and Adamawa states during the afternoon/evening hours. In the North-central region, sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the region with chances of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Plateau, the Federal Capital Territory, Kwara, Benue, Nasarawa and Kogi states during the afternoon/evening period. In the South, there are chances of morning thunderstorms over parts of Bayelsa, Rivers, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms are expected over parts of Imo, Osun, Ogun, Oyo, Ondo, Enugu, Anambra, Edo, Rivers, Cross River, Bayelsa, Akwa Ibom and Delta states.

Thursday 15th: In the Northern region, sunny skies are expected with chances of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Taraba, Adamawa, Bauchi, Gombe and Kaduna states. In the North-central region, sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated with prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Plateau, the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Niger, Benue and Kogi states during the afternoon/evening period. In the Southern region, morning thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Cross River, Bayelsa and Akwa Ibom states. Thunderstorms are expected over parts of Abia, Enugu, Anambra, Ondo, Ogun, Oyo, Osun, Lagos, Cross River, Bayelsa, Akwa Ibom and Delta states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Friday 16th: Sunny skies with few clouds are expected over the Northern region with chances of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Kaduna, Adamawa and Taraba states during the afternoon/evening period. In the North-central region, sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated with prospects of isolated thunderstorms over parts of Plateau, the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Niger, Benue and Kogi states during the afternoon/evening period. Over the Southern region, morning thunderstorms are anticipated

over parts of Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states. Later in the day, thunderstorms are envisaged over parts of Ebonyi, Imo, Abia, Anambra, Enugu, Osun, Ogun, Oyo, Ondo, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Rivers, Delta, Bayelsa and Lagos states.

Advisory:

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- ii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision
- iii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
