#### **REMARKS**

During the week, the Madden-Julian Oscillation (MJO) is expected to be weak over the West African region. Good moisture influx and velocity potential are expected to enhance the prospects of Heavy rainfall over parts Kaduna, Niger, Taraba and Adamawa states. Moderate to Heavy rainfall over parts of southern Borno, FCT, Nasarawa, Plateau, Kebbi, Benue, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Rivers, Bayelsa and Delta states. Moderate rainfall is expected over parts of Kogi, Kwara, Oyo, Ogun, Osun, Edo, Ondo, Anambra, Imo, Abia, Enugu and Ebonyi states. Low to Moderate is expected over parts of Ekit, Sokoto, Zamfara, Katsina and Kano states, while low rainfall is expected in the remaining parts of the country.

<u>Advisory</u>: There are prospects of flash floods on roads, bridges & low-lying areas which can disrupt vehicular traffic. The public is advised to take necessary safety precautions; do not walk through fast-flowing runoff waters.





FIGURE 1: SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF ANTICIPATED RAINFALL.

### 2.1 <u>Maximum Temperature</u>




# FIGURE 2: SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE FORECAST.

Maximum Temperature range of  $35 - 40^{\circ}$ C is anticipated over most parts of Borno, Yobe, Bauchi, Jigawa, Kano, Katsina, Zamfara, Niger, Kebbi and Sokoto states. Temperature range of  $30 - 35^{\circ}$ C is expected over parts of Gombe, Adamawa, Taraba, Plateau, Nasarawa, Kaduna, FCT, Kwara, Benue and Kogi states. Temperatures range of  $25 - 30^{\circ}$ C is expected over the rest parts of the country. See Figure 2.

## 2.2 <u>Minimum Temperature</u>

Minimum temperature range of 25 - 30°C is expected over parts of Kano, Katsina, Zamfara, Sokoto, Kebbi, Niger, Jigawa, Bauchi, Gombe, Nasarawa, Taraba, Adamawa, Yobe, Borno, Lagos, Ogun, Ondo, Delta, Bayelsa and Rivers States. Temperature range of 20 - 25°C is expected over the rest of the country with exception of southern Taraba state where Temperature range of 15 -20°C is expected. See Figure 3.
