WEATHER OUTLOOK ISSUED ON 08.06.2025 AND

FORECAST OUTLOOK:

Monday 9th: In the Northern region, sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected with likelihoods of morning thunderstorms envisaged over parts of Kaduna, Taraba and Adamawa states. Later in the day, thunderstorms with rains are anticipated over parts of Taraba, Adamawa, Katsina, Kano, Zamfara, Kaduna, Kebbi, Gombe and Bauchi states. In the North-central region, patches of clouds with sunshine intervals are expected with likelihoods of early morning thunderstorms over parts of Niger, the Federal Capital Territory and Kogi states. Later in the day, thunderstorms with rains are anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Niger, Nasarawa, Kwara, Kogi, Benue and Plateau states. In the Southern region, cloudy atmosphere is expected with chances of morning rains over parts of Lagos, Ogun, Ebonyi, Abia and Cross River states. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms with rains are anticipated over most parts of the southern region.

Tuesday 10th: In the Northern region, sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected with prospects of morning thunderstorms envisaged over parts of Kaduna, Zamfara, Kebbi, Sokoto and Taraba states. Later in the day, thunderstorms with rains are anticipated over parts of Taraba, Adamawa, Katsina, Kano, Zamfara, Kaduna, Kebbi, Gombe and Bauchi states. In the North-central region, patches of clouds with sunshine intervals are expected with prospects of early morning thunderstorms over parts of Niger, Nasarawa, Benue, Kwara, the Federal Capital Territory and Kogi state. Later in the day, thunderstorms with rains are anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Niger, Nasarawa, Kwara, Kogi, Benue and Plateau states. In the Southern region, cloudy atmosphere is expected with chances of morning thunderstorms over parts of Akwa Ibom and Cross River states. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms with rains are anticipated over most parts of the region.

Wednesday 11th: In the Northern region, sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected with prospects of afternoon/evening thunderstorms with rain over parts of Taraba, Adamawa, Katsina, Kano, Zamfara, Kaduna, Zamfara, Kebbi, Gombe and Bauchi states. In the North-central region, patches of clouds with sunshine intervals are expected with prospects of thunderstorms with rains over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Niger, Nasarawa, Kwara, Kogi, Benue and Plateau states in afternoon/evening hours. In the Southern region, cloudy atmosphere is expected with chances of morning thunderstorms over parts of Akwa Ibom and Cross River states. Later in the day, isolated thunderstorms with rains are anticipated over most parts of the region.

Advisory:

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- ii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
