



WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST BULLETIN NO: 202506007 ISSUED ON: 17th JUNE, 2025. VALID: FROM 17th JUNE, 2025 TO 23rd JUNE, 2025.

REMARKS

During the week, the Madden-Julian Oscillation (MJO) is expected to be weak over the West African region. Good moisture influx and velocity potential are expected to enhance the prospects of Heavy rainfall over parts southern Taraba, southern Adamawa, Delta, Bayelsa, Rivers, southern Abia, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states. Moderate to Heavy rainfall over parts of Katsina, Zamfara, Kaduna, Kano, southern Sokoto, Niger, Plateau, FCT, southern Kwara, Ado-Ekiti, Ondo, Osun, Ogun, Lagos, Edo, Anambra, Enugu, Imo and Ebonyi states. Moderate rainfall is expected over parts of Kebbi, Bauchi, Jigawa, southern Borno, Benue, Nasarawa, Kogi and Oyo states. Low to Moderate rainfall is expected over parts of Gombe state, while low rainfall is expected in the remaining parts of the country.

<u>Advisory:</u> There are prospects of flash floods on roads, bridges & low-lying areas which can disrupt vehicular traffic. The public is advised to take necessary safety precautions; do not walk through fast-flowing runoff waters.




FIGURE 1: SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF ANTICIPATED RAINFALL.

2.1 Maximum Temperature




FIGURE 2: SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE FORECAST.

Maximum Temperature range of $35-40^{\circ}$ C is anticipated over most parts of Borno, Yobe, Bauchi, Jigawa, Kano, Katsina, Zamfara, Kebbi, Zamfara, Gombe and Sokoto states. Temperature range of $30-35^{\circ}$ C is expected over parts of Adamawa, Taraba, Plateau, Nasarawa, Kaduna, Niger, the Federal Capital Territory, Kwara, Benue, Kogi, Oyo, Ogun, Anambra, Enugu, Ebonyi, Abia and Cross River states. Temperatures range of $25-30^{\circ}$ C is expected over the remaining parts of the country. See Figure 2.

2.2 <u>Minimum Temperature</u>

Minimum temperature range of 25 - 30°C is expected over parts of Borno, Yobe, Gombe, Bauchi, Jigawa, Kano, Katsina, Zamfara, Sokoto and Kebbi States. Temperature range of 20 - 25°C is expected over the remaining parts of the country with exception of Kaduna, southern Taraba and Plateau states where Temperature range of 15 -20°C is expected. 


FIGURE 3: SPATIAL DISTRIBUTION OF MINIMUM TEMPERATURE FORECAST.
