Day 1: Tuesday 24th June, 2025

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of cloud are expected over this region with prospects of morning thunderstorms over parts of Borno and Yobe states. Isolated thunderstorms (with moderate rains) are expected during the afternoon/evening hours over parts of Taraba, Bauchi, Gombe, Kano, Katsina, Sokoto, Adamawa, Kebbi and Kaduna states.

Central Region:

Sunny skies with patches of cloud are expected during the morning hours. Isolated thunderstorms (with moderate rain) are expected over parts of Plateau, Benue, the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Kogi and Niger states during the afternoon/evening periods.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over this region during the morning hours. Afternoon/evening isolated thunderstorms (with light to moderate rain) are expected over parts of Abia, Imo, Ebonyi, Enugu, Anambra, Edo, Ondo, Ogun, Delta, Ekiti, Lagos, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross Rivers and Akwa Ibom states.

Day 2: Wednesday 25th June, 2025

Northern Region:

Thunderstorms with light rains are expected over parts of Sokoto, Zamfara, Kebbi, and Kaduna states while the rest of the region will be sunny with cloud patches during the morning hours. Thunderstorms

with moderate rain are expected during the afternoon/evening hours over parts of Adamawa, Taraba, Gombe, Sokoto, Katsina, Jigawa, Kebbi, Zamfara, Kano, Kaduna and Bauchi states.

Central Region:

Morning thunderstorms with light rains are anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Niger, Kwara and Plateau states. Afternoon/evening thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Kogi, Benue, Niger, Plateau and Kwara State.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region with prospects of morning rains over parts of Cross river, Akwa Ibom, Delta, Imo, Abia, Anambra, Enugu, Ebonyi, Rivers, Bayelsa and Edo states. Thunderstorms with moderate to heavy rains are expected over the Southern region during the afternoon/evening periods.

Day 3: Thursday 26th June, 2025

Northern Region:

Thunderstorms with light rains are expected over parts of Kebbi, Zamfara, Taraba, Adamawa and Sokoto states while the rest of the region will be sunny with cloud patches during the morning hours. Thunderstorms with moderate rain are expected over Bauchi, Gombe, Adamawa, Taraba, Sokoto, Kebbi, Zamfara, Kano, Katsina, Jigawa and Kaduna states during the afternoon/evening periods.

Central Region:

Sunny skies with sunshine interval are expected over this with prospect of early morning moderate rains over parts of Nasarawa and the Federal Capital Territory. Thunderstorms with moderate to heavy rains are expected across the region in the afternoon to evening/night periods.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over this region during the morning hours. Thunderstorms with moderate to heavy rains are expected over the Southern region during the afternoon/evening periods.

Advisory

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- ii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
