Day 1: Wednesday 25th June, 2025

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of cloud are expected over this region with prospects of morning thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Zamfara, Kebbi and Katsina states. Isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected during the afternoon/evening hours over parts of Taraba, Sokoto, Adamawa, Kebbi, Zamfara and Kaduna states.

Central Region:

Sunny skies with patches of cloud are expected during the morning hours with chances of thunderstorms with rains over parts of Niger state. Isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Plateau, Kwara, the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Kogi and Niger states during the afternoon/evening periods.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over this region during the morning hours with prospects of moderate rains over parts of Ondo, Rivers, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states. Afternoon/evening isolated thunderstorms with light to moderate rains are expected over parts of Abia, Imo, Ebonyi, Enugu, Anambra, Edo, Ondo, Ogun, Ekiti, Osun, Delta, Ekiti, Lagos, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross Rivers and Akwa Ibom states.

Day 2: Thursday 26th June, 2025

Northern Region:

Thunderstorms with light rains are expected over parts of Borno, Adamawa, Taraba, Bauchi, Zamfara,

Kebbi and Kaduna states, while the rest of the region will be sunny with cloud patches during the morning

hours. Thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected during the afternoon/evening hours over parts

of Adamawa, Taraba, Bauchi, Sokoto, Kebbi, Zamfara and Kaduna states.

Central Region:

Morning thunderstorms with light rains are anticipated over parts of Niger, Kogi, Benue, Kwara and

Plateau states. Afternoon/evening thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over parts of the

Federal Capital Territory, Kogi, Benue, Nasarawa, Plateau and Kwara states.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region with prospects of morning rains over parts of Cross River,

Akwa Ibom, Delta, Imo, Abia, Anambra, <mark>En</mark>ugu, Eb<mark>onyi,</mark> Rivers, <mark>Bay</mark>els<mark>a and</mark> Edo states. <mark>Thu</mark>nderstorms

with moderate to heavy rains are expected over the Southern region during the afternoon/evening

periods.

Day 3: Friday 27th June, 2025

Northern Region:

Thunderstorms with light rains are expected over parts of Kebbi, Zamfara, Taraba and Sokoto states while

the rest of the region will be sunny with cloud patches during the morning hours. Thunderstorms with

moderate rains are expected over Adamawa, Taraba, Jigawa and Kaduna states during the

afternoon/evening periods.

Central Region:

Sunny skies with sunshine intervals are expected over this region during the morning hours.

Thunderstorms with moderate to heavy rains are expected across the region in the afternoon to

evening/night periods.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over this region during the morning hours. Thunderstorms with moderate to heavy rains are expected over the Southern region during the afternoon/evening periods.

Advisory

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- ii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
