Day 1: Saturday 5th July, 2025

Northern Region:

Thunderstorms with rains are anticipated during the morning hours over parts of Taraba, Adamawa, Sokoto, Zamfara, Kebbi, Jigawa, Bauchi, Gombe and Borno states, while the rest of the region will be sunny with cloud patches. Isolated thunderstorms with rains are expected during the afternoon/evening hours over parts of Adamawa, Taraba, Borno, Yobe, Bauchi and Kaduna states.

Central Region:

Chances of morning thunderstorms with light to moderate rains are expected over parts of Benue, Nasarawa, Niger, the Federal Capital Territory and Kwara states, while the rest of the region is expected to be sunny with cloud patches. Isolated thunderstorms with Moderate rains are expected over parts of Plateau, the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Kogi and Benue states during the afternoon/evening periods.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over this region with prospects of morning light to moderate rains over parts of Bayelsa, Lagos, Cross River, Akwa Ibom and Rivers states. Afternoon/evening hours, moderate rains are expected over parts of Ogun, Lagos, Ekiti, Ondo, Osun, Oyo, Imo, Ebonyi, Enugu, Anambra, Abia, Edo, Delta, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states.

Day 2: Sunday 6th June, 2025

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over this region during the morning hours. Thunderstorms with moderate rain are expected during the afternoon/evening hours over parts of Sokoto, Katsina, Kano, Zamfara, Bauchi, Kaduna, Adamawa, Taraba, Gombe, Yobe, Borno and Jigawa State.

Central Region:

Morning thunderstorms with light rains are anticipated over parts of Plateau, Nasarawa and the Federal Capital Territory. Afternoon/evening thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Kogi and Plateau states.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over the region with chances of morning rains over parts of Akwa Ibom, Cross River, Rivers and Bayelsa states. Moderate rains are expected over parts of Akwa Ibom, Cross River, Rivers, Lagos and Bayelsa states during the afternoon/evening periods.

Day 3: Monday 7th June, 2025

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of cloud are expected over the Northern regions with prospects of morning thunderstorms with rains over parts of Taraba, Sokoto, Zamfara and Kebbi states. Thunderstorms with heavy rains are expected over most places during the afternoon to evening periods.

Central Region:

Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region during the morning hours. Isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Kwara, Niger, the Federal Capital Territory and Kogi states during the afternoon to evening/night periods.

Southern Region:

There are prospects of morning rains over parts of Rivers, Cross River and Bayelsa states during the morning hours, while the remaining parts are expected to be under cloudy skies. Thunderstorms with moderate to heavy rains are expected over most places during the afternoon/evening periods.

Advisory

- i. *Lagos state is likely to experience Flooding in the next 24 hours.*
- ii. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- iii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iv. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- v. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
