



## Weather Outlook

### Day 1: Monday 7<sup>th</sup> July, 2025

---

#### **Northern Region:**

*Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the region with prospects of morning thunderstorms with rains over parts of Taraba, Sokoto, Zamfara, Katsina, Kano, Jigawa, Bauchi, Borno, Kebbi, and Kaduna states. Later during the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with rains are expected over parts of Adamawa, Taraba, Jigawa, Kano, Katsina, Zamfara, Kebbi, Gombe, Borno, Yobe, Bauchi and Kaduna states.*

#### **Central Region:**

*Cloudy skies with spells of sunshine are expected over the region with chances of morning thunderstorms with light rains expected over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa and Niger states. Later during the afternoon/evening periods, localized thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over different parts of the region.*

#### **Southern Region:**

*Cloudy skies are expected over this region with chances of morning light to moderate rains over parts of Imo, Abia, Ebonyi, Anambra, Enugu, Lagos, Ogun, Ondo, Delta, Bayelsa, Cross River, Akwa Ibom and Rivers states. During the afternoon/evening hours, moderate rains are expected over parts of Ogun, Ondo, Osun, Oyo, Imo, Ebonyi, Enugu, Anambra, Abia, Edo, Delta, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states.*

## Day 2: Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> July, 2025

---

### **Northern Region:**

*Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the region during the morning hours with prospects of afternoon/evening thunderstorms with moderate rain expected over the entire region.*

### **Central Region:**

*Cloudy skies with spells of sunshine are expected over the region with chances of morning thunderstorms with light rains are anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa and Niger states. Later in the day, localized thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over most parts of the region.*

### **Southern Region:**

*Cloudy skies are expected over the region with chances of morning rains over parts of Abia, Ebonyi, Akwa Ibom, Cross River, Rivers and Bayelsa states. Later in the day, moderate rains are expected over the entire region.*

## Day 3: Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> July, 2025

---

### **Northern Region:**

*Sunny skies with patches of cloud are expected over the region with prospects of morning thunderstorms with rains over parts of Sokoto, Kebbi, Katsina, Kaduna and Taraba states. Thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over the entire region during the afternoon to evening periods.*

### **Central Region:**

*Cloudy skies with spells of sunshine are anticipated over the region during the morning hours. Localized thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over most parts of the region during the afternoon to evening/night periods.*

**Southern Region:**

*Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region with chances of morning rains over parts of Delta, Akwa Ibom, Rivers, Cross River and Bayelsa states during the morning hours. Later in the day, moderate to heavy rains are expected over most parts of the region.*

**Advisory**

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- ii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
