

Weather Outlook

Day 1: Monday 14th July, 2025

Northern Region:

Cloudy skies with intervals of sunshine are anticipated over the region with slim prospects of thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Borno state during the morning hours. Thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Adamawa, Taraba, Kebbi, Bauchi, Borno and Kaduna states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Central Region:

Cloudy skies with sunny intervals will be experienced during the morning hours. In afternoon/evening hours, moderate rains are anticipated over parts of the FCT, Nasarawa, Plateau and Niger states.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over this region during the morning hours. Light rains are expected over parts of Enugu, Ebonyi, Imo, Anambra, Abia, Delta, Edo, Rivers, Bayelsa, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day 2: Tuesday 15th July, 2025

Northern Region:

Cloudy skies with intervals of sunshine are anticipated over the region during the morning hours. Thunderstorms with moderate to heavy rains are expected during the afternoon/evening hours over parts of Sokoto, Kebbi, Katsina, Kano, Kaduna, Bauchi, Gombe, Adamawa, Taraba, Bauchi, Yobe, Jigawa, Borno and Zamfara states.

Central Region:

Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region during the morning hours. Later in the day, light to moderate rains is anticipated over most parts of the region.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region during the morning hours with prospects of light rains over parts of Akwa Ibom and Cross River states. Later in the day, light to moderate rains is anticipated over most parts of the region.

Day 3: Wednesday 16th July, 2025

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the region during the morning hours. Scattered thunderstorms with moderate to heavy rains are expected over parts of Jigawa, Kebbi, Zamfara, Adamawa, Taraba, Kaduna, Borno and Yobe states in the afternoon/evening hours.

Central Region:

Cloudy skies with intervals of sunshine are expected during the morning hours. Light to moderate rains is expected over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Kogi, Niger, Plateau and Benue states during the afternoon to evening periods.

Southern Region:

There are prospects of morning rains over parts of Cross River state during the morning hours, while the remaining parts of the region is expected to be cloudy. Moderate rains are expected across the Southern region during the afternoon/evening periods.

Advisory

- i. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- ii. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- iii. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- iv. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet
 for effective planning in their operations.
