### Day 1: Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> July, 2025

---

#### **Northern Region:**

*Thunderstorms with light to moderate rains are anticipated during the early morning hours over parts of Sokoto, Katsina, Kano, Zamfara and Kebbi state while the remaining parts of the region will be sunny with patches of cloud. Thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected during the afternoon/evening hours over parts of Borno, Jigawa, Yobe, Kano, Katsina, Kaduna, Bauchi, Gombe, Taraba and Adamawa states.*

#### **Central Region:**

*Sunny skies with patches of cloud are expected over this region during the morning period. In the afternoon/evening hours, Light rains are anticipated over parts of Plateau, Nasarawa, the Federal Capital Territory, Benue, Kogi, Kwara and Niger states.*

#### **Southern Region:**

*Cloudy skies are expected over this region with prospects of morning light rains over parts of Ekiti, Edo, Delta, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states. Light rain is expected over parts of Imo, Abia, Ebonyi, Edo, Anambra, Enugu, Bayelsa, Delta, Rivers, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the afternoon/evening hours.*

### Day 2: Friday 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2025

---

#### **Northern Region:**

*Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the region during the morning hours with prospects of thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Yobe, Gombe, Jigawa, Borno, Bauchi and Taraba*

states. Thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected during the afternoon/evening hours over parts of Gombe, Kaduna, Zamfara, Kano, Katsina, Sokoto, Adamawa, Kebbi, Taraba and Bauchi states.

**Central Region:**

Morning light rains are anticipated over parts of Niger, Plateau and the Federal Capital Territory. During the afternoon/evening hours light rains are anticipated over parts of Plateau, Benue, Kogi, Nasarawa and the Federal Capital Territory.

**Southern Region:**

Cloudy skies are expected over the region with chances of morning light rains over parts of Imo, Anambra, Ebonyi, Akwa Ibom, Cross River and Rivers states. Light rains are expected over Edo, Rivers, Cross River, Delta, Akwa Ibom and Bayelsa states during the afternoon/evening periods.

**Day 3: Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> July, 2025**

---

**Northern Region:**

Sunny skies with patches of cloud are expected over the Northern regions during the morning hours. Thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Adamawa, Yobe, Taraba, Kano, Zamfara, Sokoto, Kebbi, Jigawa, Kaduna, Bauchi, Borno, Yobe, Katsina and Gombe states in the afternoon/evening hours.

**Central Region:**

Morning light rains are expected over parts of Nasarawa, Niger, the Federal Capital Territory, Kogi, Benue, Plateau and Niger states. Light to moderate rains is expected over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Plateau, Niger, Kogi, Kwara and Benue states during the afternoon to evening/night periods.

**Southern Region:**

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected during the morning hours. Light to moderate rains are expected over parts of Imo, Anambra, Ebonyi, Enugu, Abia, Edo, Rivers, Cross River, Delta, Akwa Ibom, and Bayelsa states during the afternoon/evening periods.

### **Advisory**

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- ii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
