Day 1: Friday 18th July, 2025

Northern Region:

Thunderstorms with light to moderate rains are expected during the early morning hours over parts of Borno, Yobe, Kaduna, Bauchi and Gombe states while the remaining parts of the region will be sunny with patches of cloud. Thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected during the afternoon/evening hours over parts of Adamawa, Yobe, Sokoto, Zamfara, Bauchi, Borno, Gombe, Jigawa, Kaduna and Taraba states.

Central Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected with chances of light rains over parts of Plateau and Nasarawa states during the morning period. In the afternoon/evening hours, Light rains are anticipated over parts of Plateau, the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa and Benue states.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over this region with prospects of morning light rains over parts of Imo, Abia, Anambra, Ebonyi, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states. Light rain is expected over parts of Imo, Abia, Ebonyi, Edo, Anambra, Enugu, Bayelsa, Delta, Rivers, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the afternoon/evening hours.

Day 2: Saturday 19th July, 2025

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the region throughout the morning hours. Thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected during the afternoon/evening hours over parts of Adamawa, Gombe, Jigawa, Kano, Katsina, Kebbi, Yobe, Taraba, Kaduna and Bauchi states.

Central Region:

Morning light rains are anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Plateau and Benue states. In the afternoon/evening hours light rains are anticipated over parts of Plateau, Benue, Kogi, Niger, Kwara, Nasarawa and the Federal Capital Territory.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over the region with chances of morning light rains over parts of Imo, Anambra, Ebonyi, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states. Light rains are expected over parts of Imo, Abia, Ebonyi, Anambra, Enugu, Ondo, Edo, Cross River, Delta, Rivers, Akwa Ibom and Bayelsa states during the afternoon/evening periods.

Day 3: Sunday 20th July, 2025

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the Northern regions with prospects of thunderstorms over parts of Adamawa, Taraba, Kaduna and Kebbi states during the morning hours. Thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over the region in the afternoon/evening hours.

Central Region:

Morning light rains are expected over parts of Nasarawa, Niger, the Federal Capital Territory, Kogi, Benue, Kwara and Niger states. Light to moderate rains is expected over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa, Plateau, Niger, Kogi, Kwara and Benue states during the afternoon / evening hours.

Southern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds and Light to moderate rains are expected over parts of Imo, Anambra, Ebonyi, Enugu, Ondo, Cross River, Akwa Ibom and Bayelsa states during the morning hours. Light rains are expected over parts of Imo, Abia, Ebonyi, Anambra, Enugu, Ondo, Edo, Rivers, Cross River, Delta, Rivers, Akwa Ibom and Bayelsa states during the afternoon/evening periods.

Advisory

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- ii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
