Day 1: Friday 15th August, 2025

Northern Region:

There are prospects of morning thunderstorms with moderate rains in parts of Borno, Gombe, Bauchi, Yobe, Jigawa, Taraba, Katsina, Kaduna and Kano states. Later during the afternoon to evening hours, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over the entire region. There is high possibility of flood occurring in parts of Kebbi, Kaduna, Sokoto, Bauchi, Taraba, Katsina and Zamfara states during the forecast period.

Central Region:

There are prospects of intermittent light rains in parts of Plateau, Nasarawa, Benue, Kogi, the Federal Capital Territory and Niger states during the morning period. In the afternoon/evening hours, moderate rains are anticipated in parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Plateau, Niger, Nasarawa, Benue, Kwara and Kogi States. There is high possibility of flood occurring in parts of Nasarawa, Plateau and Niger states during the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over the region with prospects of light rains in parts of Rivers, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the morning period. Later in the afternoon/evening period, moderate rains are expected in parts of Oyo, Osun, Edo, Ondo, Ogun, Ekiti, Abia, Imo, Delta, Ebonyi, Rivers, Lagos, Bayelsa, Akwa Ibom, Cross River and Lagos states. There is high possibility of flood occurring over parts of Cross River state during the forecast period.

Day 2: Saturday 16th August, 2025

Northern Region:

Morning thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated in parts of Bauchi, Gombe, Kano, Taraba, Yobe, Borno, Kaduna, Katsina, Jigawa, Sokoto and Zamfara states. Thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected in part of Katsina, Bauchi, Taraba, Gombe and Kaduna states during the afternoon/evening hours. There is high possibility of flood occurring over parts of Zamfara, Kebbi, Sokoto, Borno and Bauchi states during the forecast period.

Central Region:

There are prospects of Light rains in parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Niger, Nasarawa, Plateau, Benue, Kwara and Kogi states during the morning period. In the afternoon/evening hours, intermittent light rains are anticipated over the region. There is high possibility of flood occurring in parts of Kwara, Niger, Kogi and the Federal Capital Territory during the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are expected over the region with prospects of light rains to affect parts Oyo, Ogun, Enugu, Anambra, Abia, Imo, Ondo, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the morning period. Later in the afternoon/evening period, the rains are expected to continue over part of Enugu, Edo, Oyo, Ogun, Osun, Ondo, Ekiti, Delta, Lagos, Bayelsa, Cross River and River States.

Day 3: Sunday 17th August, 2025

Northern Region:

Morning thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated in parts of Katsina, Kano, Gombe, Kaduna, Borno, Jigawa, Yobe and Taraba states. Thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected in parts of Kebbi, Kaduna, Jigawa, Bauchi, Taraba and Adamawa states during the afternoon/evening hours. There is high possibility of flood occurring in parts of Borno, Gombe, Bauchi, Jigawa, Kaduna and Yobe states during the forecast period.

Central Region:

Light rains are anticipated in parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Nasarawa and Niger states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, moderate rains are anticipated in parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Niger, Plateau and Kwara states. There is high possibility of flood occurring in parts of Kogi and Plateau states during the forecast period.

Southern Region:

Light rains are expected over parts of Ondo, Osun, Cross River and Lagos states in the morning period.

The rains are expected to continue in parts of Ondo, Osun, Ogun, Edo, Delta, Ebonyi, Cross River, Akwa

Ibom and Rivers state during the afternoon/evening period.

Advisory

- i. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- ii. The states with possibility of Flash Flood should activate emergency response system, immediately.
- iii. To avoid leaching of nutrients, farmers should refrain from applying fertilizer and pesticides right before the rains.
- iv. Ensure warm clothing for the vulnerable persons due to low night-time temperatures.
- v. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- vi. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
