

## **Weather Outlook**

Day 1: Wednesday 10th September, 2025.

## **Northern Region:**

There are prospects of thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Taraba, Adamawa, Kebbi, Borno, Zamfara, Gombe, Bauchi, Kaduna and Katsina states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over most parts of the region.

## **Central Region:**

There are prospects of Light rains over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Kwara, Niger and Kogi states in the morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Nasarawa, Niger, Plateau, Kogi, Kwara, Benue and the Federal Capital Territory.

### **Southern Region:**

Cloudy skies are expected over the Southern region with chances of light rains over parts of Ebonyi, Imo, Abia, Oyo, Ogun and Edo states during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening period, moderate rains are anticipated over the region.

Day 2: Thursday 11th September, 2025.

### **Northern Region:**

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected over the region with prospects of thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Kebbi, Kaduna, Borno, Taraba, Adamawa and Bauchi states during the morning hours. During the afternoon and evening hours, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over most parts of this region.

## **Central Region:**

There are prospects of Light to moderate rains over parts of Niger, Kwara, Nasarawa, Benue and the Federal Capital territory during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorm with moderate rain is anticipated over parts of Niger, Nasarawa, Benue, the Federal Capital territory and Plateau state.

### **Southern Region:**

Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region with chances of moderate rains over parts of Oyo, Ebonyi, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the morning hours. Later during the afternoon/evening period, light rains are expected over parts of Imo, Abia, Enugu, Ebonyi, Edo, Ondo, Oyo, Ogun, Osun, Delta, Rivers, Lagos, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states.

## Day 3: Friday 12th September, 2025.

### **Northern Region:**

Cloudy skies with intervals of sunshine are expected over this region with chances of thunderstorm with moderate rains over parts of Bauchi, Borno, Adamawa and Taraba states during the morning period. During the afternoon/evening period, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over most parts of the region.

### **Central Region:**

Cloudy skies with intervals of sunshine are expected over this region with prospects of moderate rains over parts of Nasarawa, Kogi, Plateau and the Federal Capital Territory during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorm with moderate rain is anticipated over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Kwara, Kogi, Plateau, Nasarawa and Niger states.

#### **Southern Region:**

Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region with prospects of moderate rains over parts of Ebonyi, Enugu, Ondo, Anambra, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening periods, moderate rains are anticipated over most parts of the region.

# **Advisory**

- i. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- ii. To avoid leaching of nutrients, farmers should refrain from applying fertilizer and pesticides right before the rains.
- iii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
