Day 1: Saturday 13th September, 2025.

Northern Region:

There are prospects of thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Katsina, Kano, Adamawa, Gombe, Bauchi, Borno and Taraba states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorms with light rains are envisaged over parts of Borno, Adamawa, Taraba, Gombe, Bauchi, Sokoto, Zamfara, Katsina, Kano, Kaduna, Jigawa and Kebbi states.

Central Region:

There are chances of isolated thunderstorms and moderate rains over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Benue, Nasarawa and Niger states within the morning hours. Later in the day, there are good prospects of Isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Niger, Nasarawa, Plateau, Kwara, Kogi, Benue and the Federal Capital Territory.

Southern Region:

There are prospects of light to moderate rainfall over parts of Ogun, Ondo, Oyo, Edo, Delta, Lagos, Rivers, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rainfall is anticipated over parts of Imo, Abia, Enugu, Anambra, Ebonyi, Oyo, Ondo, Osun, Ogun, Ekiti, Lagos, Edo, Delta, Rivers, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states.

There are prospects of Flooding over parts of Delta, Lagos, Rivers, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states.

Day 2: Sunday 14th September, 2025.

Northern Region:

There are prospects of thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Taraba, Adamawa, Gombe, Borno, Kaduna, Kebbi and Sokoto states during the morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms with light rains are likely over parts of Gombe, Yobe, Taraba, Adamawa, Borno, Bauchi, Jigawa, Sokoto, Kebbi, Kaduna, Zamfara, Kano and Katsina states.

Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected over the region with chances of thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over parts of Niger, Kogi and Benue states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorm with moderate rain is envisaged over parts Nasarawa, Plateau, Kwara, Kogi, Benue, Niger and the Federal Capital Territory.

Southern Region:

There are prospects of thunderstorms accompanied by light to moderate rainfall over parts of Lagos, Ogun, Edo, Ebonyi, Imo, Abia, Rivers, Bayelsa, Delta, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorm with moderate rain is envisaged over parts of Ebonyi, Abia, Imo, Enugu, Anambra, Osun, Oyo, Ekiti, Ondo, Ogun, Edo, Delta, Lagos, Akwa Ibom, Rivers, Bayelsa and Cross River states.

Day 3: Monday 15th September, 2025.

Northern Region:

Cloudy skies with intervals of sunshine are expected over this region with chances of thunderstorm accompanied by light rains over parts of Taraba, Adamawa, Gombe, Borno, Kaduna, Kebbi, Sokoto, Jigawa, Zamfara, Kano and Bauchi states during the morning period. In the afternoon/evening period, isolated thunderstorms with light rains are expected over Gombe, Yobe, Taraba, Adamawa, Borno, Bauchi, Jigawa, Sokoto, Kebbi, Kaduna, Zamfara, Kano and Katsina states.

Central Region:

Cloudy skies with intervals of sunshine are expected over this region with prospects of thunderstorm with moderate rain over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Kwara and Niger states during the morning periods. Later in the day, thunderstorms with moderate rains are envisaged over parts of Nasarawa, Plateau, Kwara, Kogi, Benue, Niger and the Federal Capital Territory.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region with prospects of thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Imo, Abia, Ebonyi, Edo, Delta, Ebonyi, Akwa Ibom, Cross River, Rivers and Bayelsa states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening periods, thunderstorms with moderate rains are anticipated over parts of Ebonyi, Abia, Imo, Enugu, Anambra, Osun, Oyo, Ekiti, Ondo, Ogun, Edo, Delta, Lagos, Akwa Ibom, Rivers, Bayelsa and Cross River states.

Advisory

- i. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- ii. To avoid leaching of nutrients, farmers should refrain from applying fertilizer and pesticides right before the rains.
- iii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
