Day 1: Monday 15th September, 2025.

Northern Region:

There are prospects of isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Kaduna, Gombe, Bauchi, Kebbi, Adamawa and Taraba states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Borno, Jigawa, Kano, Kaduna, Adamawa, Gombe, Bauchi and Katsina states. There are prospects of Flash Floods over parts of Adamawa, Taraba and Gombe states.

Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with sunshine Intervals is expected over this region during the morning hours with chances of moderate rains over Niger, Kogi, Kwara, the Federal Capital Territory and Benue states. Later in the day, Isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over most parts of the region.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region with chances of moderate rains over parts of Ekiti, Ondo, Rivers, Akwa Ibom and Cross River states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening periods, moderate rains are anticipated over most parts of the region.

Day 2: Tuesday 16th September, 2025.

Northern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected over the region with prospects of Isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over Borno, Kaduna, Gombe, Bauchi, Taraba and Adamawa states during the morning period. Later in the afternoon/evening period, isolated thunderstorms with moderate

rains are expected over parts of Kano, Taraba, Jigawa, Yobe, Kaduna, Katsina, Kano, Zamfara and Kebbi State.

Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected over the region with chances of moderate rain over parts of Kogi, Niger, the Federal Capital Territory, Kwara and Nasarawa states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorm with moderate rain is anticipated over parts of Niger, Kogi, Kwara, Benue and the Federal Capital Territory.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region with chances of moderate rains over parts of Oyo, Ekiti, Ondo, Enugu, Anambra, Ebonyi and Delta States during the morning hours. Later during the afternoon/evening period, light to moderate rain is expected over most parts of the region.

Day 3: Wednesday 17th September, 2025.

Northern Region:

Cloudy skies with intervals of sunshine are expected over this region with slim prospect of thunderstorm with light rains over parts of Sokoto and Zamfara states during the morning period. During the afternoon/evening period, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Borno, Adamawa, Taraba, Kaduna, Zamfara, Kebbi and Sokoto state.

Central Region:

Cloudy skies with intervals of sunshine are expected over this region with prospects of thunderstorm with Light rain over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Kogi, Kwara and Niger states during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, there are prospects of isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Benue, Kwara, Kogi and Niger state.

Southern Region:

Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening periods, moderate rains are anticipated over most parts of the region.

Advisory

- i. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- ii. To avoid leaching of nutrients, farmers should refrain from applying fertilizer and pesticides right before the rains.
- iii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
