Day 1: Tuesday 16th September, 2025.

Northern Region:

*There are prospects of isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Kaduna, Gombe, Bauchi, Kebbi, Sokoto, Adamawa and Taraba states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Borno, Yobe, Taraba, Jigawa, Kano, Kaduna, Zamfara, Sokoto, Kebbi, Adamawa, and Katsina states. **There are prospects of Flash Floods over parts of Kaduna and Taraba states.***

Central Region:

*Cloudy atmosphere with sunshine Intervals is expected over this region during the morning hours with chances of moderate rains over Niger, Nasarawa, Plateau, Kwara, the Federal Capital Territory and Benue states. Later in the day, Isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over most parts of the region. **There are prospects of Flash Floods over parts of Kwara, Niger and Benue states***

Southern Region:

*Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region with chances of moderate rains over parts of Rivers, Akwa Ibom, Cross River states and most parts of the south western region of the country during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening periods, moderate rains are anticipated over most parts of the region. **There are prospects of Flash Floods over parts of Cross River states.***

Day 2: Wednesday 17th September, 2025.

Northern Region:

*Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected over the region with prospects of Isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Kaduna, Taraba, Adamawa, Zamfara, Sokoto, and Kebbi states during the morning period. Later in the afternoon/evening period, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over most parts of the region. **There are prospects of Flash Floods over parts of Taraba states***

Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is expected over the region with chances of moderate rain over parts of Niger, Nasarawa and Benue states during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, thunderstorm with moderate rain is anticipated over most parts of the region.

Southern Region:

*Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region with chances of moderate rains over parts of Akwa Ibom and Cross River states during the morning hours. Later during the afternoon/evening period, moderate rain is expected over most parts of the region. **There are prospects of Flash Floods over parts of Cross River, Ebonyi, Enugu, Imo, Abia and Akwa Ibom states***

Day 3: Thursday 18th September, 2025.

Northern Region:

Cloudy skies with intervals of sunshine are expected over this region with slim prospect of thunderstorm with light rains over parts of Sokoto, Zamfara, Bauchi, Adamawa, Taraba and Kebbi states during the morning period. During the afternoon/evening period, isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Adamawa, Taraba, Kaduna, Zamfara and Sokoto state.

Central Region:

Cloudy skies with intervals of sunshine are expected over this region with prospects of thunderstorm with moderate rain over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Kogi, Plateau, Kwara, Benue, Nasarawa and

Niger states during the morning hours. Later in the afternoon/evening hours, there are prospects of isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Kwara, Nasarawa, Plateau and the Federal Capital Territory.

Southern Region:

*Cloudy skies are anticipated over the region with prospects of light rains over Ondo, Ekiti, Osun and most parts of south east and south south region during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening periods, moderate rains are anticipated over most parts of the region. **There are prospects of Flash Floods over parts of Cross River and Akwa Ibom states***

Advisory

- i. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- ii. To avoid leaching of nutrients, farmers should refrain from applying fertilizer and pesticides right before the rains.
- iii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
