### **Day 1: Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> March, 2026.**

---

#### **Northern Region:**

*Sunny skies are expected over the northern region with chances of thunderstorms with or without rains over Taraba, Adamawa, Southern Kebbi and Southern Kaduna during the afternoon/evening hours.*

#### **North Central Region:**

*Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated in the morning hours. There are prospects of thunderstorms accompanied by light rains over parts of Benue, Kwara, Plateau, Nasarawa, Kogi and the Federal Capital Territory during the afternoon/evening periods.*

#### **Southern Region:**

*Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated with prospects of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by light rains over parts of Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Bayelsa and Rivers states during the morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains are expected over parts of Enugu, Anambra, Imo, Abia, Edo, Ebonyi, Oyo, Ogun, Ekiti, Ondo, Osun, Delta, Lagos, Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Bayelsa and Rivers states*

### **Day 2: Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2026.**

---

#### **Northern Region:**

*Sunny skies are expected over the northern region with chances of thunderstorms with or without rains over Taraba and Southern Kaduna during the afternoon/evening hours.*

#### **North Central Region:**

*Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated with chances of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by light rains over parts of Kogi, Benue, Kwara, Nasarawa and the Federal Capital Territory during the afternoon /evening hours.*

**Southern Region:**

*Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated across the Southern region with chances of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by light rains over parts of Cross River, Akwa Ibom and Rivers states during the morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Lagos, Ondo, Ogun, Osun, Ekiti, Oyo, Imo, Enugu, Ebonyi, Anambra, Abia, Edo, Bayelsa, Rivers, Akwa Ibom, Cross River and Delta states.*

**Day 3: Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> March, 2026.**

---

**Northern Region:**

*Sunny skies are expected over the northern region with chances of thunderstorms with or without rains over Taraba during the afternoon/evening hours.*

**North Central Region:**

*Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated across the region with chances of isolated thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Kogi, Nasarawa, Niger and the Federal Capital Territory during the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms are expected over parts of Kogi, Benue, Plateau, Nasarawa and Kwara states.*

**Southern Region:**

*Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated across the Southern region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by light rains over parts of Cross River, Akwa Ibom, Ekiti, Ogun, Oyo, and Lagos states during the morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts Lagos, Ondo, Ogun, Oyo, Ekiti, Osun, Imo, Enugu, Abia, Anambra, Ebonyi, Edo, Bayelsa, Rivers, Akwa Ibom, Cross River and Delta states.*

**Advisory**

---

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution.
- ii. Ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- iii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.

- iv. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- v. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- vi. Temperatures are expected to remain high causing thermal discomfort. The public is advised to wear breathable clothing, stay in a well-ventilated environment and stay hydrated.
- vii. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
