Day 1: Tuesday 31st March, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the northern region with prospects of thunderstorms over parts of Taraba, Adamawa, Borno, Yobe, and Kaduna states during the morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorm accompanied by moderate rains are expected over parts of Taraba, Bauchi, Yobe, Gombe, Kaduna, and Adamawa states.

North Central Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are anticipated over the region with chances of early morning isolated thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Plateau, Benue and Nasarawa states. Later in the day, thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains are expected across the region.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the region with prospects of morning thunderstorms over parts of Ondo, and Edo states. Later in the day, thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains are expected over the entire region.

Day 2: Wednesday 1st April, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the northern region with prospects of thunderstorms over parts of Taraba, Adamawa, southern parts of Borno, Bauchi and Kaduna states during the afternoon/evening hours.

North Central Region:

Cloudy skies with sunny intervals are expected over the region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Plateau, Benue and Nasarawa states

during the morning hours. Later in the day, widespread thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected across of the region.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over parts of Ondo, and Edo states during the morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over the entire southern region.

Day 3: Thursday 2nd April, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with a few patches of clouds are expected over the northern region during morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Adamawa, Kaduna, and Taraba states.

North Central Region:

Isolated thunderstorms are anticipated over parts of Nasarawa, Kogi, Plateau and Benue states in the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms are expected over most parts of the region.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with strong chances of thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over Lagos, Edo, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the morning hours. Widespread thunderstorms are anticipated across the region during the afternoon/evening hours.

Advisory

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution and ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- ii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iii. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- iv. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.

- v. Temperatures are expected to remain high causing thermal discomfort. The public is advised to wear breathable clothing, stay in a well-ventilated environment and stay hydrated.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
