Day 1: Wednesday 1st APRIL, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the northern region during the morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorm accompanied by light rains are expected over parts of Taraba state.

North Central Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the region during the morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms accompanied by light rains are expected over parts of Kogi and Benue states.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the region with prospects of morning thunderstorms over parts of Akwa Ibom, and Cross River states. Later in the day, thunderstorms accompanied by light rains are expected over the entire region.

Day 2: Thursday 2nd April, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the northern region with prospects of thunderstorms with light rains over parts of Taraba and Kaduna states during the morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains are expected over parts of Adamawa, Taraba, Borno, Gombe, Bauchi and Kaduna states.

North Central Region:

Cloudy skies with sunny intervals are expected over the region with prospects of isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of the Federal Capital Territory, Plateau, Benue and Nasarawa states during the morning hours. Later in the day, widespread thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected across of the region.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over parts of Akwa Ibom and Cross River states during the morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over the entire southern region.

Day 3: Friday 3rd April, 2026.

Northern Region:

Sunny skies with patches of clouds are expected over the northern region during morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over parts of Adamawa, Borno, Gombe, Kaduna, and Taraba states.

North Central Region:

Isolated thunderstorms are anticipated over the region in the morning hours. In the afternoon/evening hours, isolated thunderstorms are expected over most parts of the region.

Southern Region:

Cloudy atmosphere with strong chances of thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over Lagos, Osun, Ogun, Ondo, Delta, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the morning hours. Widespread thunderstorms are anticipated across the region during the afternoon/evening hours.

Advisory

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution and ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- ii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iii. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- iv. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- v. Temperatures are expected to remain high causing thermal discomfort. The public is advised to wear breathable clothing, stay in a well-ventilated environment and stay hydrated.
- vi. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
