### **Day 1: Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2026.**

---

#### **Northern Region:**

*Sunny skies are anticipated over the region during the morning hours. There are prospects of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over parts of Bauchi, Gombe, Kaduna, Adamawa, Southern Borno and Taraba states during the afternoon/evening hours.*

#### **North Central Region:**

*Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the region during the morning hours with chances of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over Niger, Kogi, Kwara, Nasarawa and the Federal Capital Territory. There are prospects of thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Plateau, Kogi, Niger, Nasarawa and the Federal Capital Territory during the afternoon/evening hours.*

#### **Southern Region:**

*Cloudy atmosphere is expected over the region during the morning hours with chances of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over parts of Lagos, Southern Ondo, Enugu, Edo, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states. There are prospects of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over parts of Oyo, Ebonyi, Enugu, Abia, Osun, Ekiti, Anambra, Ondo, Ogun, Edo, Imo, Delta, Bayelsa, Rivers, Lagos, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the afternoon/evening hours.*

## **Day 2: Friday 17<sup>th</sup> April, 2026.**

---

### **Northern Region:**

*Sunny skies are anticipated over the Northern region during the morning hours. There are prospects of thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over parts of Kaduna, Adamawa, Taraba, Bauchi, Gombe, and Southern Borno states during the afternoon/evening hours.*

### **North Central Region:**

*Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the region in the morning hours. There are prospects of thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over parts of Benue, the Federal Capital Territory, Kogi, Nasarawa, Niger, Kwara and Plateau states during the afternoon/evening hours.*

### **Southern Region:**

*Cloudy atmosphere is anticipated over the region during the morning hours with chances of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by light rains over parts of Rivers, Delta, Bayelsa, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states. There are prospects of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over parts of Bayelsa, Rivers, Delta, Cross River and Akwa Ibom states during the afternoon/evening hours.*

## **Day 3: Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> April, 2026.**

---

### **Northern Region:**

*Sunny skies are anticipated over the region during the morning hours with chances of thunderstorms with rain or without rain over parts of Borno, Gombe, Taraba and Adamawa states. There are prospects of isolated thunderstorms accompanied by moderate rains over parts of Kaduna, Gombe, Bauchi, Taraba, Katsina, Kano, Zamfara and Adamawa states during the afternoon/evening hours.*

### **North Central Region:**

*Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the North central region during the morning hours. There are prospects of isolated thunderstorms with moderate rains over parts of Plateau, Nasarawa, Kogi, Niger, Kwara, Benue and the Federal Capital Territory during the afternoon/evening hours.*

**Southern Region:**

*Cloudy atmosphere with intervals of sunshine is anticipated over the region during the morning hours. Later in the day, thunderstorms with moderate rains are expected over the entire southern region.*

### Advisory

---

- i. Strong winds may precede the rains in areas where thunderstorms are likely to occur, public should take adequate precaution and ensure that loose objects are fastened to avoid collision.
- ii. Driving under heavy rain should be avoided.
- iii. Disconnect electrical appliances from electrical sockets.
- iv. Stay away from tall trees to avoid impact from falling branches and broken trees.
- v. Airline operators are advised to get airport-specific weather reports (flight documentation) from NiMet for effective planning in their operations.
- vi. Temperatures are expected to remain high causing thermal discomfort. The public is advised to wear breathable clothing, stay in a well-ventilated environment and stay hydrated.
